Care Information

DO

Use tablecloths, table runners and coasters to help protect surfaces from scratching. Certain ranges have a more raw appearance to accentuate their beauty and require extra care. Treat spills quickly with a damp cloth.Dust once a week using a soft cloth or similar duster. Use felt pads on the base of vases or similar items to avoid scratcing

DO NOT


Avoid placing hot or wet items directly on the surface as they can leave marks which are difficult to remove.


Avoid direct sunlight, as this will cause colour change. If the furniture is in direct sunlight, move items like vases around to avoid spotting.

Don't place potted plants on timber or veneers unless it is water tight or in a tray.


Avoid supermarket polishes and waxes as many contain high levels of silicon and petroleum distillate which can damage the surface.


Timber designed for indoor use should not be left outside. Its finish is not designed for use outdoors.







Sideboard 2.1m with centre leg






4.Insert the fireplace into sideboard.

- DO NOT ALLOW small children to climb on to Drawers, Shelves or to swing from open doors.




For your safety when attaching the anti-tilt fixings;

It is important that you use the appropriate wall fixing for your wall type.








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Lateral Movement





What it looks like

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- The door will not be flush with the side panel.


- How to fix it
- To move the door towards the centre of the unit, loosen screw "A". Adjust the door and the tighten screw "B".
- To move the door away from the centre of the unit, loosen screw "B". Adjust the door and then tighten screw "A".

Vertical Movement



What it looks like


- The door will not be flush with the vertical panel.



How to fix it


 To move the door towards or away from the horizontal panels, loosen screws "C".
Adjust the door and the tighten screws "C"

Horizontal Movement



What it looks like

- The door will appear too far for or too close from the front edge of the side panel.



How to fix it

- To move the door or towards or away from the unit, loosen screw "A". Adjust the door forwards or backwards until there is an even gap between the door and the front edge of the side panel.
 - Tighten screw "A" once the adjustment has been made.
